RÍO TEXAS CONFERENCE SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

Developing Leaders Vision Team Higher Education

The Río Texas Annual Conference Developing Leaders Vision Team administers three scholarship programs for Río Texas Conference undergraduate students. Scholarships are merit awards and will be awarded annually by the Conference Higher Education Team. High-school seniors through college seniors seeking their first undergraduate degree are eligible to be nominated for these programs. Funding for these awards is based on a rebate resulting from the response of the Annual Conference to the United Methodist Student Day Offering, interest accrued yearly, and on contributions to the Advance Special #2017.

The Advance Special #2017 for Higher Education Scholarships receives individual, small group and congregational gifts in any amount to apply to merit scholarships. Contributions sent through the local church will help that congregation reach Five Star recognition.

Nomination Guidelines from the Higher Education Team & the GBHEM are as follows:

- 1. Awards are limited to full-time United Methodist students who have been members of a church in the Conference for at least one year, high school seniors through college seniors who are seeking their first undergraduate degree.
- 2. Awards are for "merit," but it should be understood that merit can be in terms of Academic Scholarship, Church Involvement, Financial Need, Special Vocational Preparation for Ministry, or other service or a combination of these factors, as may be determined by the conference team.
- 3. Awards shall be made by the Conference Higher Ed Team on the basis of an academic year.

Additional Guidelines Specific to each Award are as follows:

Craven-Wilson Merit Award ranging from \$400 to \$3,000

- 1. Nominee must be enrolled or enrolling in Texas Wesleyan University.
- 2. Nomination comes from a United Methodist church (pastor and/or Administrative Council) in the Río Texas Conference.
 - a. Nominations shall be sent to the Scholarship Team of the Conference Higher Ed on the official form supplied here.
 - b. A Río Texas Conference church may nominate no more than one student annually for this award.
 - c. Included with the nomination shall be a statement from the sponsoring church pastor and/or other church official describing the student's involvement in church, school, community or other organizations, and why the nominee merits this special recognition.
- 3. Award shall be made to the student as a part of that student's or his/her parents' contribution to the cost of education upon receipt of proof of enrollment from the registrar of the institution. The annual conference team's intention is to ensure that the award payment does not displace any other aid to which the student may be entitled.
- 4. Deadline for nominations is April 1, each year.

Albert & Nancy Wilson Merit Award ranging from \$400 to \$3,000

- 1. Nominee must be enrolled or enrolling in an accredited college or university.
- 2. Nomination comes from a United Methodist church (pastor and/or Administrative Council) in the Rio Texas Conference.
 - a. Nominations shall be sent to the Scholarship Team of the Conference Higher Ed on the official form supplied here.
 - b. A Río Texas Conference church may nominate no more than one student annually for this award.
 - c. Included with the nomination shall be a statement from the sponsoring church pastor and/or other church official describing the student's involvement in church, school, community or other organizations, and why the nominee merits this special recognition.
- 3. Award shall be made to the student as a part of that student's or his/her parents' contribution to the cost of education upon receipt of proof of enrollment from the registrar of the institution. The annual conference team's intention is to ensure that the award payment does not displace any other aid to which the student may be entitled.
- 4. Deadline for nominations is April 1, each year.

General Board of Higher Education and Ministry (GBHEM) Merit Award ranging from \$500 to \$1,000

- 1. Applications available, online only, January 3 through March 7, 2024(dates subject to change) at www.gbhem.org/scholarshipapplication.
- 2. Applicant must be enrolled or enrolling in an institution of higher education recognized as <u>United Methodist</u> by the University Senate. It shall not be required that the institution be within the bounds of the annual conference from which the award originates. Information for United Methodist-related schools may be found at www.gbhem.org/education.
- 3. Applicant must have a GPA of 2.5 or higher.
